What is The Journey of Dohntbe A. Cinaman?

The Journey of Dohntbe A. Cinaman is a weekly four-panel Catholic comic strip published every Sunday in parish bulletins and at doit4God.org. Fifty-six episodes have been published in a local parish bulletin without interruption, with a further 33 episodes produced and ready to deploy.

The strip follows Dohntbe Cinaman — a good-natured, likeable, thoroughly modern Catholic who finds every reasonable excuse not to take his faith too seriously. His wife Faith, their three children, and the occasional appearance of his agnostic sister SinDee form a warm family portrait that millions of Catholics will recognise immediately.

The name says it all: CINA stands for Catholic In Name Alone. Pronounced “sinner man.” The whole arc of the strip is Dohntbe’s slow, warm, often funny journey from earning that name to outgrowing it.

DC Dohntbe A. Cinaman

Husband · Dad · Age 34

The lovable stray sheep. Good-natured, slightly ruffled, and always ready with a perfectly reasonable excuse not to go to Mass. He is not a bad man — just a convenient one. The lapsing Catholic's mirror.

FC Faith Cinaman

Wife · Devout Catholic · Age 34

The anchor. Her faith is joyful, not burdensome. She never lectures — she plants seeds and trusts God with the harvest. Her quiet wisdom is remarkable for her age. Auburn hair, sparkling green eyes.

HC Hope, age 12

Miniature Faith · Blonde hair · Green eyes

Firmly committed to her faith and excited by it. States the obvious holy thing with complete sincerity — without realising how devastating it is. A proto-evangelist in school uniform.

TC Thomas, age 9

Hungry for holiness · Red hair · Blue eyes

Questions not from doubt but from desire. Wants to be a Saint and is frustrated the path seems hard. Patron: St. Thomas Aquinas. Accidentally devastating with his literal-minded logic.

CC Charity, age 6

The innocent · Red hair · Green eyes

Speaks truth without knowing it. The punchline or the gut-punch. Embodies Matthew 18:3 — the child the adults need to become. Used sparingly for maximum impact.

SD SinDee Cinaman

Dohntbe's sister · Agnostic actress

Worldly, warm, genuinely fond of the family. Not hostile to the faith — simply indifferent to it. The bridge character: secular readers may see themselves in her more than in Dohntbe.

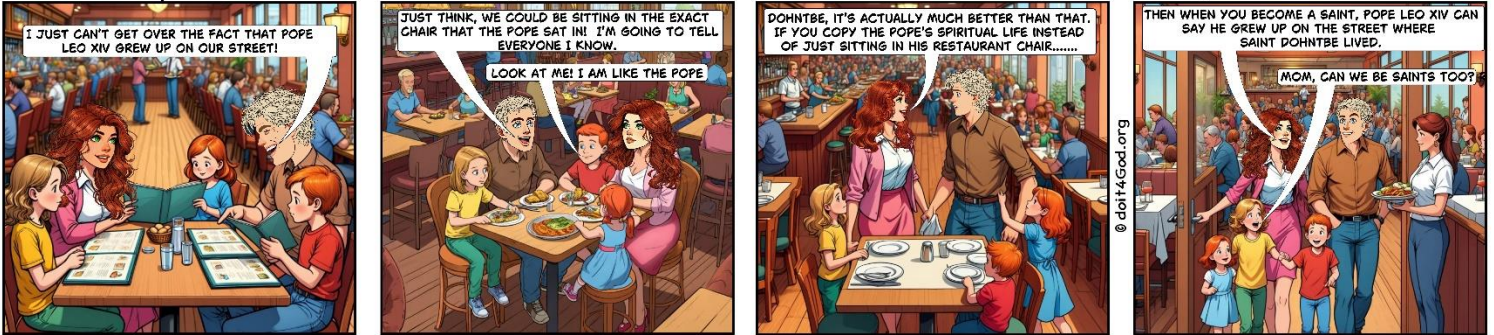
Sample Strips

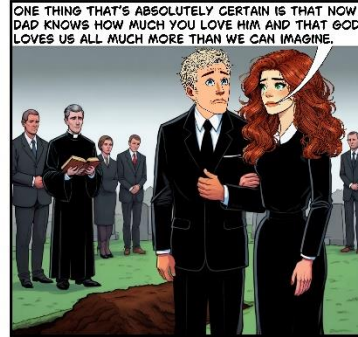

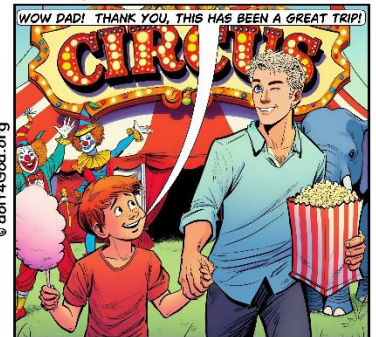

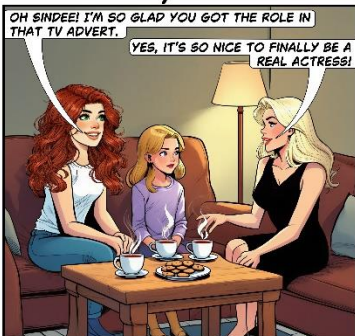

Track Record

56 strips published. 33 episodes currently in production.

The Journey of Dohntbe A. Cinaman has been published every Sunday without exception in a local parish bulletin since its launch — 56 consecutive published strips across Ordinary Time, Lent, Easter, Advent, Christmas, and major feast days. A further 33 episodes have been produced and are ready to deploy immediately. Episode concepts are in development up to episode 93.

For any new publisher, this means: no gap weeks, no scramble, no waiting for new material. A substantial ready-made archive is available from day one.

The audience this strip is designed for

According to CARA (the Center for Applied Research in the Apostolate at Georgetown University), approximately 24% of US Catholics attend Mass weekly. With a Catholic population of around 61 million, that means roughly 46 million US Catholics are lapsed, occasional, or marginal in their practice. This is Dohntbe’s audience — and it is the largest underserved audience in American Catholicism.

Most Catholic media is written for the 24% already in the pew. The Journey of Dohntbe A. Cinaman is written for the 76% who aren’t — and designed to reach them through the bulletin of the parish they still occasionally attend.

The archive covers:

- The Sacraments — Confession, Eucharist, Marriage
- Prayer, Lent, and the liturgical seasons
- The Saints — featuring St. Thomas Aquinas, St. John Capistrano, the Cristero martyrs
- Contemporary Catholic life — social media, gaming, streaming, workplace faith
- Family, marriage, grief, temptation, and conversion
- The pro-life issue, handled with pastoral care and restraint

Syndication — Free to Publish

The Journey of Dohntbe A. Cinaman is offered free of charge to all Catholic publications, parish bulletins, diocesan newspapers, school newsletters, and digital platforms.

This is a ministry, not a commercial enterprise. The strip's only purpose is to reach the lapsing Catholic with warmth, humour, and genuine theological depth — and to make the faith look worth returning to.
